



Level 2 Powerboat Handling (PBL2)

This two-day entry level course provides the skills and background knowledge needed to drive a powerboat and is the basis of the International Certificate of Competence.

It focuses on low speed close quarters handling, man overboard recovery, an introduction to driving at planing speed, and collision regulations.

Assumed knowledge None.	May be preceded by Level 1 although this is not a requirement.
Duration	2 days
Course content	Launch and recovery, boat handling, securing to a buoy, anchoring, leaving and coming alongside & man overboard.
Ability after the course	Self sufficient powerboater in the right conditions, aware of own limitations and those of craft.
Minimum age	12. Candidates under the age of 16 will be issued with an endorsed certificate
Maximum teaching ratio	3 students: 1 instructor
